



**Chevy Chase, Nov 9, 2014** Recently I booked with Ship Overseas, Inc for the transport of my motorcycle to Chile. So the plan now is for The Mule to leave from Baltimore on Dec 11 aboard ro-ro vessel M/V Torino heading to San Antonio, where she will arrive on Jan 8 of next year. I've also bought my own air ticket: I will leave from Washington on Jan 7 on United heading to Santiago, where I will arrive on the following day.

I have also made some progress on the route. As I have stated before, my priority will be to get to Ushuaia before I run out of money

again! With this in mind, I came up with a base plan that will take me from Santiago to Ushuaia in three weeks, and then back up to Buenos Aires in two more. See the map below for a general overview of what it looks like. Basically it will be through the "middle" on the way south, and then along the coast heading north. After BA we enter into the realm of the "highly hypothetical," so not much work done as of yet on this part of the route!

On the motorcycle front, just did the 24,000 mile schedule maintenance at Bob's BMW. I now need to make a decision on tires, and The Mule will be ready to go.
